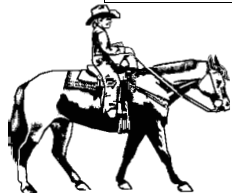

### Divisions:

Beginner Rider:	Rider is 12 or under.
Novice Rider:	Rider, 13 & older, new to showing regardless of discipline.
Green Horse:	Rider any age, may cross enter open lope classes.
Junior Rider:	Rider is 17 or under.
Senior Rider:	Rider is 18 or older.

**Equestrians under 18 must wear an ASTM approved helmet, securely fastened, while mounted or otherwise handling a horse, on any part of Silver Sands property.**

- Ribbons: First through sixth places.
- Negative Coggins is required - there are no exceptions.
- Judging based on AQHA, USA Equestrian & SSBC rules. Judges decisions are final.
- All ties broken by Horsemanship Class.
- All stallions must be handled by an adult (18 or older).
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs allowed on SSBC grounds.
- All riders must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" Release form.
- SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property.
- Required - appropriate dress, boots, tack and, if under 18, ASTM helmets must be worn.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.**
- Classes may be divided if entries warrant.
- To qualify for end of day High Point, same horse and rider team is required to go in Showmanship, Pleasure and Horsemanship in their chosen division.**
- To be eligible for Series Awards, the same horse / rider combination must qualify for high point in at least four out of the SIX shows.



- Non-Blue Horse and Rider combo must never have placed first, riding in any judged show.
- Beginner and Novice Rider must never have cantered in a judged show.
- The Novice and Green Horse Divisions are limited to two years.
- Green Horse Division is open to Horses in their first or second year of showing.
- The Green Horse may enter in open Lope classes but no other division classes..
- Novice Rider is a rider new to showing with less than two years experience.
- Horse/Rider team may not cross over high point divisions in any classes.**
- \*\*\*Jackpot Classes - Choose only one, Amateur or Open. An amateur is one who does not receive payment for training, lessons, etc.**
